## “Owl Moon” by Jane Yolen, illustrated by John Schenherr

Read with *Great Horned Owl* by Herter’s, Inc., in Folk Art, Upper Level.

In the story, what are the little girl and her dad looking for? Do they find it? Do you ever take walks as a family? What kinds of things do you look for?

Take a look at the *Great Horned Owl* sculpture. It’s made of painted wood, with glass eyes and a claw beak. It was made the same size and colors as a real owl to trick other birds.

Explore the rest of the Folk Art Galleries, and look for other kinds of birds. Can you find a duck? An eagle? A rooster?
