



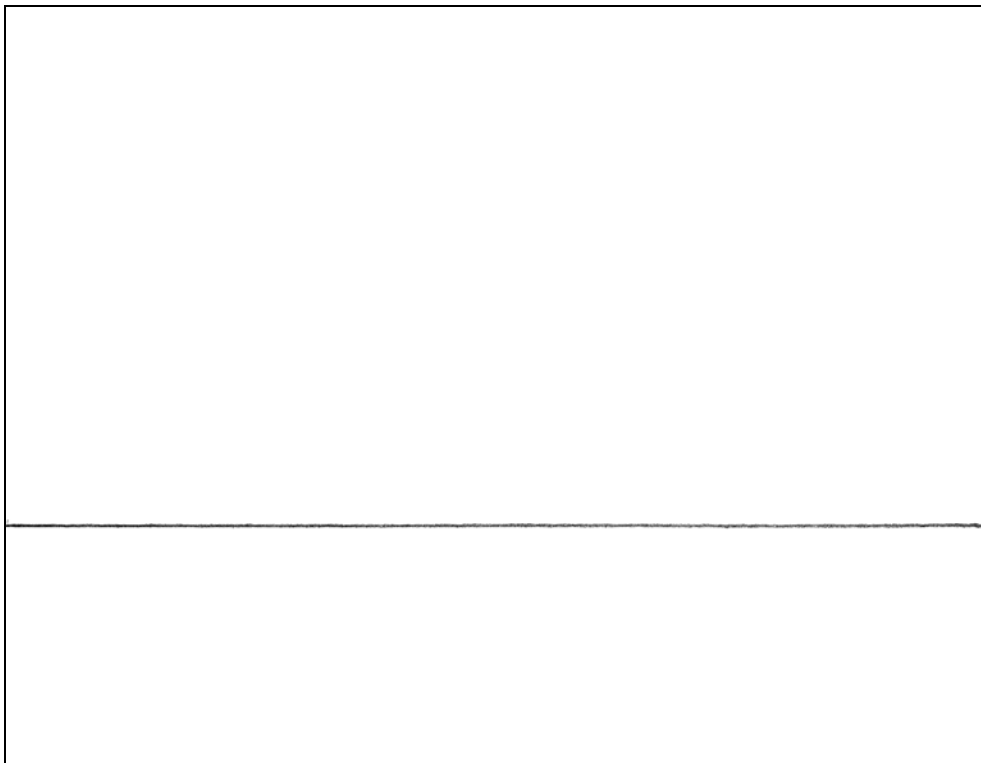

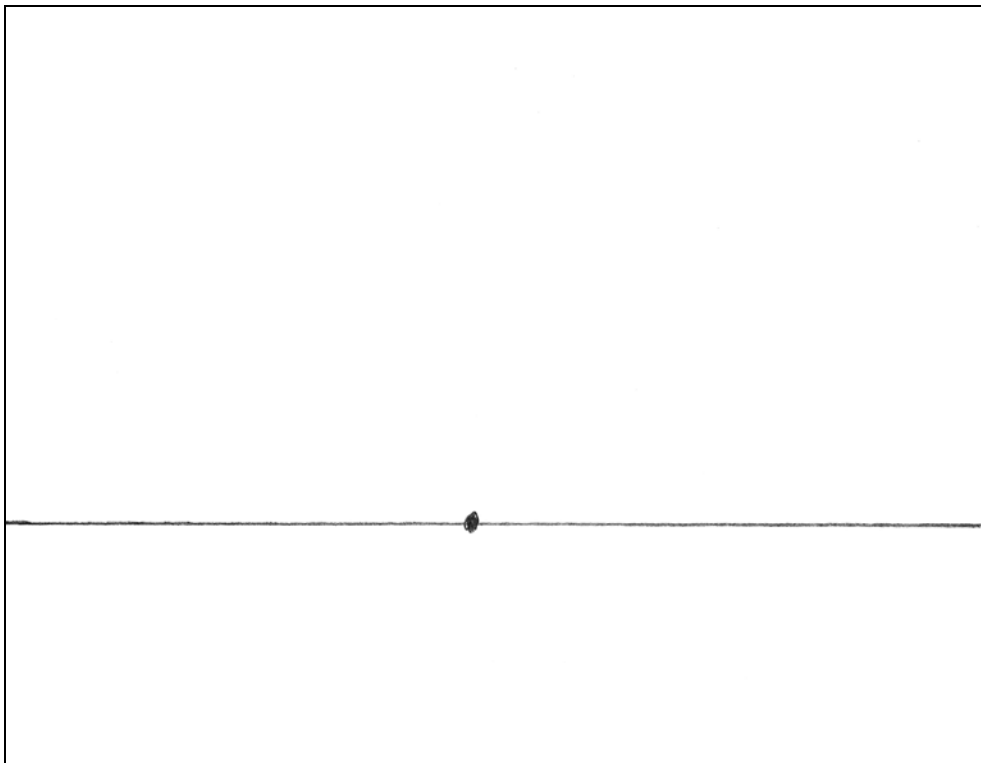

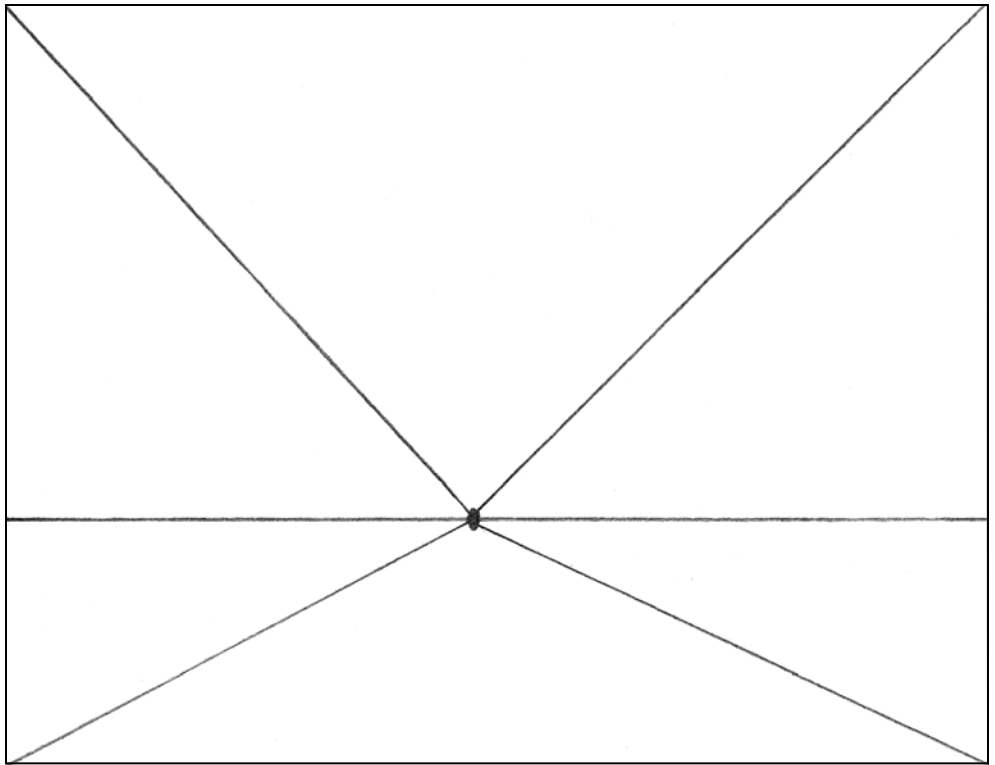
One-Point Perspective Step-by-Step



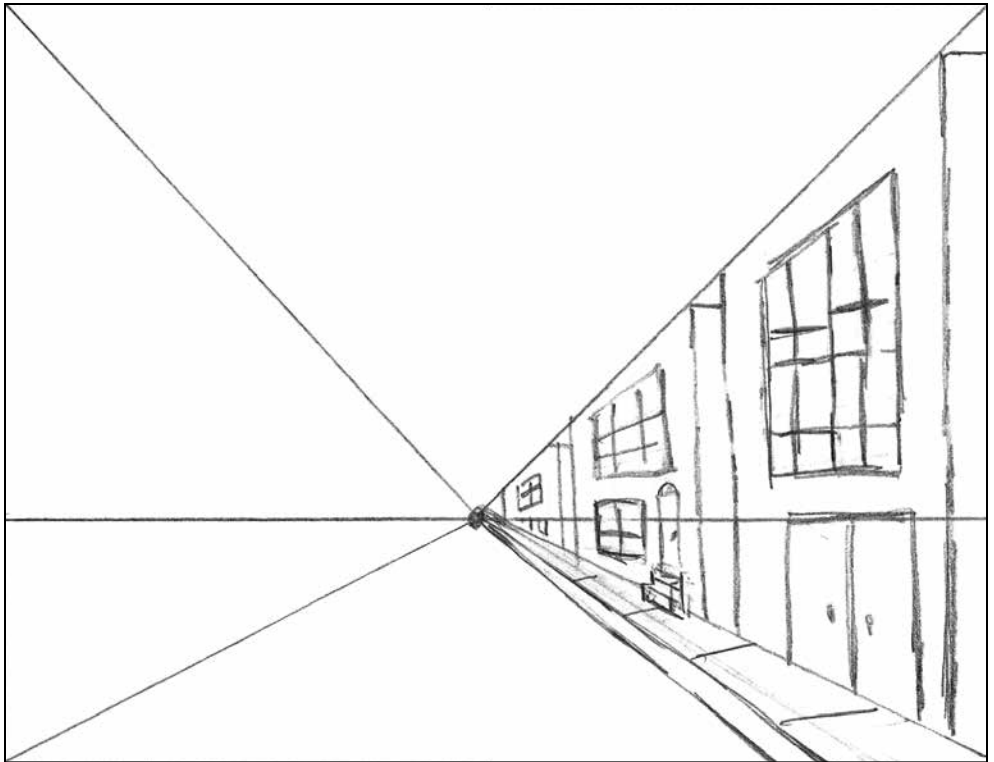
**Use a ruler to draw a horizontal line on your paper.
This is your horizon line.**



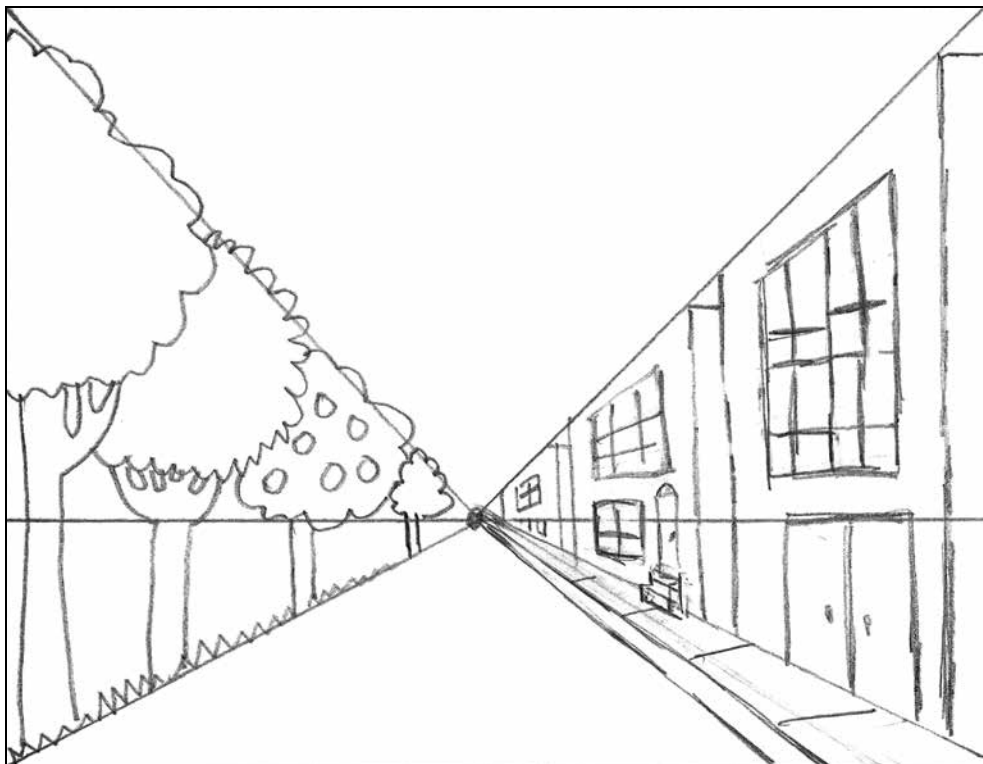
Add a dot on the horizon line. This is the vanishing point.



Use a ruler to draw lines from the vanishing point to the corners of the page. These are called converging lines.



Sketch buildings inside the converging lines on the right. Buildings will get smaller the closer they are to the vanishing point.



**Sketch trees inside the converging lines on the left.
Trees will get smaller the closer they are to the vanishing point.**



Erase unneeded lines. Color your scene!
