You don't need an art background or any specific information to play this game.


There are no right or wrong answers to Art Quest's questions.

Use the left column on each page for your first selected work of art, then choose another work of art and use the right column of each page to play the game again.


Begin by selecting a work of art anywhere in the Museum — it's your choice!
